

**Special Education Transportation Task Force  
May 5, 2010 Minutes**

Each network gave a brief status report.

Bob Kurtz reported most of the \$100,000 had been allocated or obligated for consultative support to the following networks: South Coast, Southern Worcester/ Worcester, Blackstone Valley, BICO and FLLAC. Bob gave brief reports on state special projects. A MASBO survey sent to business managers had 120 responses. Approximately 50 respondents were interested in learning more about the task force's transportation project.

Colleen reported on the status of DMR proposed regulatory changes and the State Report on special education transportation.
